




**ASSOCIATION PROVIDES THE FOLLOWING SERVICES:**

# AGREEMENT WITH THE MINISTRY OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION




The Association has signed an agreement with the Ministry of Economic Development of the Russian Federation on cooperation in the field of:


- Creating and developing of technology parks as part of the Federal project "Acceleration of small and medium enterprises"
- Improving of the efficiency of technology parks and the investment attractiveness of special economic zones by regularly monitoring of them
- Improving of the quality of management of technology parks by training both the employees of the technology parks managing companies and representatives of executive bodies of the Russian regions




In 2019, the legislation on the state support for technology parks were prepared with contribution from the Association's experts:



**Russian government Resolution No. 1863 of December 27, 2019.**  
Approved requirements for industrial technology parks and managing companies of industrial technology parks and rules for confirming compliance with the requirements



**Russian government Resolution No. 110 of February 11, 2019.**  
Established rules for granting subsidies to technology parks as part of the national project "Small and medium-sized entrepreneurship and support for individual entrepreneurial initiative"



**Order of the Ministry of Economic Development of Russian Federation No.125 of March 14, 2019.**  
Established requirements for both technology parks and cluster development centers

Experts of the Association have contributed to the Administration of the President of the Russian Federation in preparing a report on the effectiveness of the state support measures for technology parks. The report's conclusions has formed the basis of **the President's instructions No. 2245-Pr of November 4, 2019.**



As a result of the work of the expert group, with participation of the Association's experts, it has been recommended for the Ministry of Economic Development of the Russian Federation to support 7 applications for obtaining the state support amounted to US\$ 44.7 million from the Federal budget for the period of 2020-2021.



The Publication includes III National SEZs Investment Attractiveness Index 2019 with the rating of 16 SEZs out of 13 Russian regions




Core federal and regional forums

Representatives of the Association of Clusters and Technology Parks of Russia have taken part in more than 80% of targeted federal and regional forums.



Practical Conference "Industrial Russia 4.0" has been first held in the format of a "brainstorming".

Within the framework of the conference, formed project groups analyzed existing **federal and regional support measures**, discussed the development of **scientific, technical and industrial cooperation in clusters**, considered the prospects of **international cooperation and export development**, as well as the creation of new services for Clusters' participants, residents of Technology Parks and Special Economic Zones.

Proposals formulated by the project groups were systematized by the experts of the Association and sent to the industry-specific government bodies and development institutions.

In 2019, the Association in cooperation with the Institute of Knowledge Economy prepared and launched an educational programme "Industrial Technology Parks: creation and operation management"




**Thematic plan of the educational programme:**

Module 1. Industrial Technology Parks and scope of their application

Module 2. Commercialization in Industrial Technology Parks



The purpose of the educational program is development of practical competencies for the creation and management of Industrial Technology Parks on the basis of the Russian best practices and international experience



The format of the educational programme full-time and distance, 32 academic hours. Upon completion of the educational programme, students are got Certificates of Professiona.

➤ **33 specialists were trained in the educational programme in 2019**

➤ **In 2020, new groups of students within the educational programme are to be formed as well as a range of new educational programmes for managing of the engineering infrastructure are to be developed**



1. Assistance in forming a unified regulatory framework and requirements for Technology Parks at the federal level in order to fulfill the President's instructions No.2245-Pr of November 4, 2019
2. Participation in implementation of new investment, innovation and industrial policy instruments (Special Investment Contract 2.0, Agreements on Investment Protection and Promotion, as well as Innovative Scientific Technological Centers, etc.)
3. Participation in the "reset" of regional industrial policy instruments pursued by the Ministry of Industry and Trade of Russia so as to increase the competitiveness of regional industry and develop cross-industry cooperation
4. Participation in establishing a unified mechanism for development of territories pursued by the Ministry of Economic Development of Russia
5. Research of foreign experience in supporting residents of Technology Parks
6. Strengthening international cooperation, including promotion of the Russian clusters, Technology Parks and Special Economic zones abroad, as well as participation in the United Nations Development Programme
